Progress of implementation

- First systems to be integrated will be academic
 - Synergy (SIS) & MAP data in progress
 - Canvas to follow during 2019-2020
- Integration of OneSolution and other human resources, financial, and operations data to come later





Progress of implementation

- Schoolzilla is on track to be available to CCPS principals and central office by the start of 2019-2020 school year.
 - Availability to teachers at discretion of central office and principals.
- Schools will receive greatly-improved data for 2019-20
 - Academics: robust testing and grading histories
 - Attendance and discipline: daily updates
 - Early-warning indicators



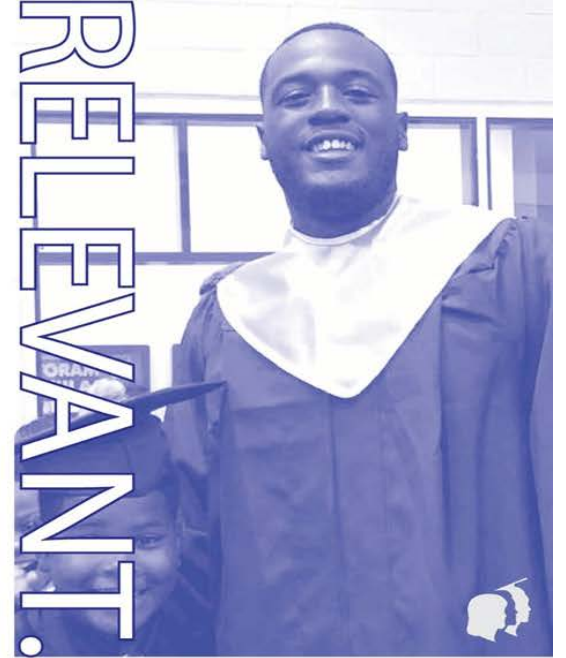
