

A strong partnership between teachers and parents helps increase the chances of a student's success. Chesterfield County Public Schools remains committed to engaging and involving middle and high school parents in their children's education through effective two-way communication.

ParentVUE is a web-based tool and a mobile application available from the iTunes store and the Google Play store that allows parents to monitor their child's academic progress. This new system will replace Edline during the 2014-15 school year and will provide parents with a look at their child's attendance, classwork and grades. In addition, this feature allows for online communication between home and school.

If you have multiple children at one secondary school and/or children at multiple secondary schools, you will only need to activate your account once. You should be able to access all of your children through that one account. (If you are unable to do so, please contact the school of the child not visible in your account.)

To log on to the ParentVUE portal for the first time follow these steps in order:

1. Enter the web address **<https://parentvue.ccpsnet.net>** into the browser
2. Click on the link that states: "I am a parent"
3. Click on the "Activate My Account" link on the following page
4. Review the Privacy Statement and click "I accept" if you agree
5. Enter your first name, last name, and activation key in the next screen exactly as they appear in your activation letter
6. Click on the "Continue to Step 3" button
7. Create your own username and password when prompted. The password must have a minimum of 6 characters, and can consist of numbers and letters
8. Enter your primary email address. This address will be used to recover your password if you lose it
9. Click on "Complete Account Activation" to finish setting up the account

Once you have signed on, please take a few minutes to become familiar with the application. Teachers are expected to update their class information at least every two weeks. If you have questions about your child's work, please contact the teacher directly. If you have questions about ParentVUE, please call your school.
