			<u>Social:</u>
			Begins to control behavior
			Begins to share with others
			Starts to follow rules
			Pays attention for short periods of time
			Separates from parents without being upset
			Understands and follows short, two- or three-step directions
			Speaks clearly and in complete sentences
			<u>Language Arts Readiness:</u>
			Uses pencils, crayons, and paper
			Holds and looks at a book correctly. Knows that words are what you read.
			Can say or sing simple nursery rhymes and songs.
			Listens to stories without interrupting
			Writes name with first letter capital, rest lower case
			Begins to identify some upper case alphabet (10 or more)
			Begins to identify some lower case alphabet (10 or more)
			Uses pronouns such as "me" or "you" correctly
			<u>Math Readiness:</u>
			Counts to 10
			Counts objects to 5 by pointing to each item
			Begins to recognize some numerals (0-10)
			Sorts objects by color, size or shape
			Completes a puzzles with more than 4 pieces
			Understands big, little, tall, short
			<u>General:</u>
			Knows basic colors (red, blue, green, black, brown, purple, yellow, orange)
			Identifies basic body parts (head, shoulders, waist, ankle, wrist, chest, knee, back)
			Uses fine motor skills (cut with scissors, holds a pencil correctly)
			Throws ball overhead
			Hops and stands on one foot up to 5 seconds
			Builds a tower with at least 6 blocks
			Draws a person with at least 4 body parts
			Dresses and undresses self
