



## GET SEVENTH-GRADE READY!



Virginia students are required to get these vaccines before entering seventh grade:

- **Tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis (Tdap):** The Tdap vaccine is required by law for all students entering seventh grade.
- **Meningococcal conjugate (MenACWY):** Students are required to have one dose of MenACWY vaccine before entering seventh grade.
- **Human papillomavirus (HPV):** The HPV vaccine is required by law for students entering seventh grade. After reviewing educational materials approved by the Board of Health, the parent/guardian may elect for their student not to receive the HPV vaccine with no additional paperwork required by Chesterfield County Public Schools. Ask your health-care provider about the benefits of the HPV vaccine.

**Get your vaccines now.** Call today to make a wellness appointment with your health-care provider and get your shots updated. Health Department immunizations are available by appointment only for children age 18 and under. To schedule an appointment, call 804-768-7454.

**Inform your school.** Provide a copy of the immunization record to your high school as soon as possible.
