

Transitioning Back Into Public School

When an elementary or middle school student enters Chesterfield County Public Schools (CCPS) from a home instruction program, the principal shall determine grade placement based on evidence of achievement provided by the parent or guardian. If further evidence is necessary, consultation with school staff or testing may be required.

A student requesting credit for high school courses taken during home instruction shall provide CCPS with a list of courses taken, the objectives for the courses, and evidence of achievement. The courses for which credit is desired must generally match the description of or can be substituted for courses for which the receiving school gives standard credit. If the evidence of achievement is determined to be insufficient, the principal can require the student to take an examination in each grade or course for which he or she wishes to establish placement or credit. Any credit granted by CCPS for courses taken under home instruction shall be designated on the student's scholastic record as credit transferred from home instruction.
