

PSAT/SAT/AP Testing

High school age home instruction students may participate in Advanced Placement tests and the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (PSAT/NMSQT). Please contact the School Counseling department of your child's homebased high school by September 15th for test registration information and cost for each test. The PSAT exam is given each year in October and AP exams are administered in May.

Students will register for the SAT or ACT tests directly on the websites below and may choose any school location available. Not all CCPS administer these tests.

Section 22.1-254.1 requires that the parent submit to the Office of Home Instruction by August 1 each year evidence of satisfactory achievement by home-instructed students in grades 1 through 12. You may submit one of the following:
"Evidence that your child has attained a composite score in or above the fourth stanine on any nationally-normed standardized test or an equivalent score on the **ACT, SAT or PSAT test**
