Now is the time. GET SEVENTH-GRADE READY!



The Tdap vaccine is required by law for all students entering seventh grade. Tdap provides protection against tetanus, diphtheria, and whooping cough.

Call today to make a wellness appointment with your health-care provider and get your shots updated. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, your health-care provider may be providing wellness appointments at limited times. So, don't wait to make your appointment.

GET THE BOOSTER SHOT NOW! Then, please provide a copy of the immunization record to your middle school as soon as possible.

The HPV vaccine is required by law for students entering seventh grade. The parent/guardian may elect for their student not to receive the HPV vaccine with no additional paperwork required by CCPS. Ask your health-care provider about the benefits of the HPV vaccine.

Effective July 1, 2021, students are required to have one dose of Meningococcal Conjugate Vaccine prior to entering seventh grade. Meningococcal vaccines help protect against the bacteria that cause meningococcal disease.

The Health Department immunizations are available to children ages 18 and under by appointment only. To schedule an appointment, please call 804-768-7454.
