



Smoke Alarm Program

The purpose of the program is to ensure a minimum level of protection consisting of one working smoke alarm on each occupied level of the home.

Chesterfield Fire & EMS has the following options:

- **Battery-powered smoke alarms** - installation to any resident in need to achieve the minimum level of protection
- **Assistive Devices** (strobe light smoke alarms or bed shaker alarms) - for those who are hearing impaired or deaf
- **Replacement battery assistance** - for older adults/disabled persons, or those needing help.

*** The fire department does not replace hardwired electric powered smoke alarms. A battery powered smoke alarm can be installed to provide temporary protection.

If you live in a rental unit/apartment, the landlord/property maintenance should replace batteries and smoke alarms, as needed. However, if they are not taking action, please call.
