

CCPSOnline

For middle and high school students, CCPSOnline provides a flexible alternative to the traditional school setting. Courses are taught by Chesterfield County Public Schools teachers licensed in the content areas. Students have opportunities to interact with the teacher and peers throughout the course but do not follow a daily bell schedule.

Courses are delivered and communication occurs within the Canvas learning management system. Students can interact with the course and course content anytime, anywhere. Most are full-year courses, but some electives are offered on a semester basis. Some courses require an exam and/or Standards of Learning test. We collaborate with your home school and school counselor to provide student supports. At the completion of each course, all grades are a part of the student's official transcript.

The Virginia Department of Education has approved Chesterfield County Public Schools as a multidivision online provider, which allows students from other school divisions to take courses through CCPSOnline. The NCAA has approved CCPSOnline as a nontraditional program. Non-resident students must request a transcript to be added to their official transcript in their resident school records.
